



COVID CAMPING NEED-TO-KNOWS THRU AT LEAST 7/31/2020
UPDATED 6/29/2020

Dear Campers,

We want to assure you that we take the health and well-being of our community, guests and staff very seriously. Like you, we're closely monitoring the quickly developing effects of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

If anyone in your party is feeling sick or may have been exposed to the virus, they must stay home. We are required to conduct a health screening upon check in whereby, if a determination is made that anyone in the party is at risk, we must refuse entry to the entire party.

To help prevent the spread of COVID-19, we are closely following the guidelines issued by the State of NH and the CDC. **Therefore, we have implemented some new policies, including but not limited to:**

CURBSIDE CHECK IN:

Upon arrival, remain in your vehicle and follow directions on posted signs. You will stay to the right and call the office at 603-447-5092 to check in.

-If possible, in order to expedite the check in process, please call the office before arrival to pay any remaining balance.

-Please email rabies certificates to easternslopecamping@yahoo.com and be sure to include the reservation name and number.

-We will only be accepting credit cards for payments and purchases, no cash please.

-A COVID-19 information sheet will be distributed at time of check in.

QUARANTINING:

Everyone must sign a Symptom Statement and/or a Quarantine Statement upon check-in.

SOCIAL DISTANCING:

-Social distancing will be required throughout the campground. You must be at least 6' apart at all times.

-When impossible to remain 6' apart, you must wear a cloth face mask.

-Public gatherings will be limited to a maximum of 8 people with at least 6' of distance between people at all times.

AMENITIES:

-Our laundry room is open with Covid-19 mitigation in place.

-We are renting canoes and kayaks with Covid-19 mitigation policies in place.

- -The pool, basketball, volleyball and bocce courts are now open, each limited to 10 people at a time.

ACTIVITIES:

- All activities including the Firetruck Hayride, Arcade, and Ice Cream Social will be suspended until further notice.

CAMP STORE:

- -Our store will be open according to our normal seasonal schedule and social distancing protocols in place. You must wear a mask in the store at all times.

BATHHOUSES:

- -Bathhouses will be cleaned and disinfected in accordance with CDC standards and will be allocated to individual families and groups whenever possible and social distancing of at least 6' will be practiced.
- -Self-contained campers are asked to use their own bathrooms and showers until further notice.

THE DUMPING STATION:

-The dumping station is open for use. It will be disinfected according to CDC standards. **PLEASE USE GLOVES!**

VISITORS:

- -We are now accepting visitors for our guests. Please follow our normal visitor procedures.
- -There continues to be a limit of 8 checked in people per site at any given time. Please let us know at or before check-in.

AREA ATTRACTIONS:

- -Visit the Mount Washington Valley Chamber of Commerce website for the most current updates on area attractions and events.
- -New Hampshire State Parks require you to reserve parking passes ahead of time online, so please be mindful of this and check out their website before you visit.
